

Welcome to the Looking Glass Visiting Stations

The Springs Living Looking Glass is a large panel of Plexiglass that separates residents from others, much like how families have been visiting residents through glass windows. They were built by employees of The Springs Living to help residents safely visit with loved ones for Mother's Day. Communities that don't have a looking glass have found other safe ways to unite residents with loved ones through virtual visits.

Guidelines for the Looking Glass:

- The visitors will always remain outside of the community walls during the Looking Glass visit.
- Only one resident/couple will visit with up to four guests at a time. Visits are booked for 20 to 45 minutes long, depending on their community.
- Residents and visitors will wear masks until they are safely behind the glass. They must put their mask back on before walking away from the glass.
- No items may pass around the Looking Glass. There will be an opportunity to drop off gifts through staff upon arrival.
- The time between visits is dedicated for our staff to thoroughly sanitize the Looking Glass between each use.
- Visits will occur with direct oversight of our staff to ensure that safety practices are always followed.
- To schedule an appointment, call the receptionist at your community.
